
"Chinese Lantern" Friendship Block

Block Size -- $6" \times 6"$ finished $(6\frac{1}{2}" \times 6\frac{1}{2}"$ with seam allowance)



| Diagram: | Fabric: | Cutting Directions: |
|---------------------|------------------------------------------------------------------|----------------------------------------------------------|
| Tan (background) | Light Beige | (4) 2" squares (2) 2" x 2½" rectangles |
| Print (lantern) | Any Print | (2) 2" x 6½" rectangles (1) 1½" x 6½" rectangle |
| Narrow Strips | Solid or tone-on- tone to coordinate with lantern print | (2) 3/4" x 6½" rectangles |
| Black | Black | (1) 2½" x 3½" rectangle |

Assembly Instructions:

- 1. Mark a diagonal line between opposite corners on the four background squares. With right sides together, place one square at each end of a 2" wide lantern strip, making sure that the diagonal marked lines are oriented in the opposite direction. Sew along the line; press the square in half along the seam line, toward the outer corner. (Optional: trim away the excess fabric triangles ¼" away from the seam line.) Repeat with the remaining squares and 2" lantern strip.
- 2. Join a background rectangle to each end of the black rectangle. Press seams toward the black fabric. Cut this unit in half lengthwise to make two $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- 3. Following the diagram, assemble the strips to form the block. Press seams as desired.
- 4. Write your name, year and hometown on each block. Turn in your blocks when you check in at QW2015.
- 5. For each block you bring, you will receive one entry in the drawing for friendship blocks, so the more blocks you bring, the more chances you have to win!

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
