Friendship Block pattern

Welcome! We're glad you have registered for this year's Quilt Wyoming and hope you enjoy making the friendship block. I designed it with Quilt Wyoming's Theme and the Raffle Quilt in mind using earth colors in my sample and in the drawings on this page.

If you want to use other colors for your block that is entirely up to you.

Please write your **name, date and hometown** in the center of the white diamond. When you arrive at Quilt Wyoming 2009 in Cheyenne, turn your finished block(s) in at the registration desk to be entered in the drawing for a "stack of blocks" made up of those turned in. You will be entered in the drawing once for each block you turn in.

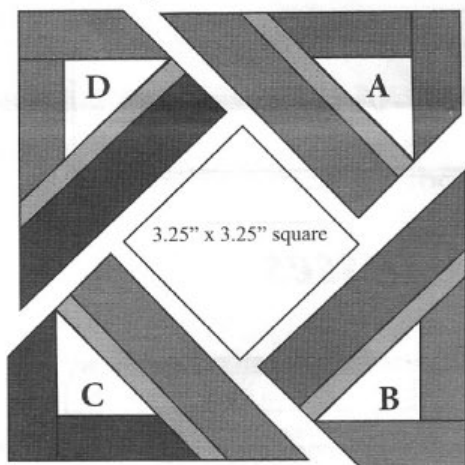

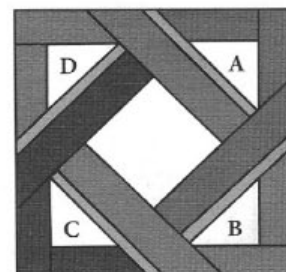
If you need some guidance with paper piecing ask a quilt friend or check with your local quilt store for help.

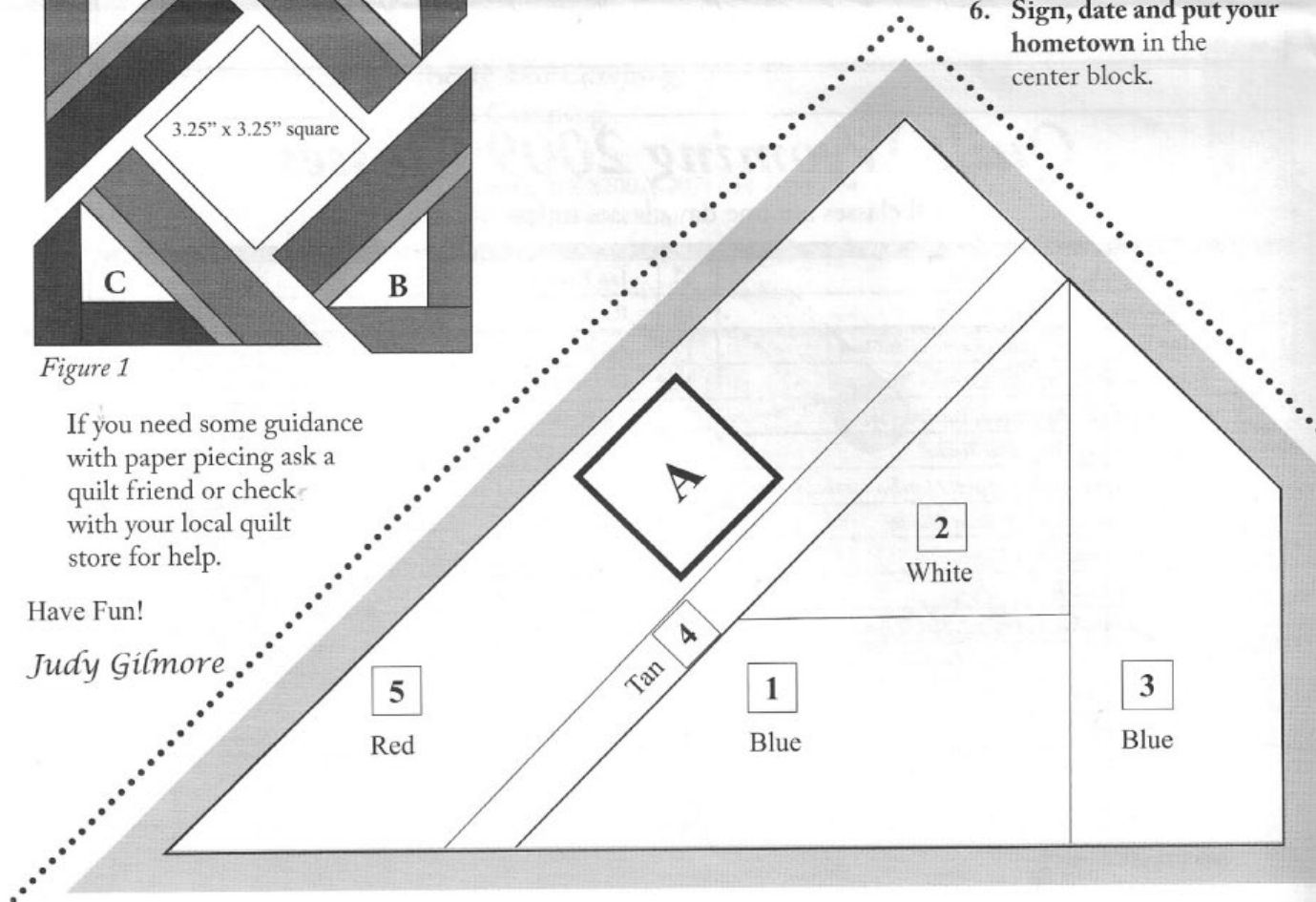
Instructions

1. Cut the individual paper pattern sections (A, B, C and D) apart **on** the dotted lines.
2. Paper piece each section following the order and suggested colors on that piece.
3. Trim each completed corner piece to be 1/4" wider than the solid **BLACK** line (approximately the width of the gray border).
4. Sew each corner piece to a 3.25" square of white (tone on tone) fabric as shown in Figure 1. (Hint: Sew the first side you attach only part way and finish attaching it to the 3.25" square after all the other corner pieces have been attached.)
5. Trim the uneven outside edges into an unfinished block that is 8.5" x 8.5".

6. Sign, date and put your hometown in the center block.
