

A UFO Sighting - Friendship Block 2017

MORNING STAR

Our Morning Star Block is floating around somewhere up there with our UFO's! You will need three fabrics to make this 9.5" unfinished friendship block.

Cut:

A 8 3.5" squares (dark blue sky)

B 6 2" squares (bright jewel)

C 1 3.5" square (light jewel)

Mark a diagonal line on the back side of all six "B" squares. Lay two "B" squares right sides together on opposite corners of fabric "C". Lay last four "B"'s on a corner of four different "A" squares.

Sew on drawn lines on "B" squares. Press toward the corner. Cut off the two back layers. Lay pieces out, referring to diagram for placement. Four plain "A's" go in the corners. The C square is in the center. The last four "B" squares are arranged to form the star. (Check the diagram again!) Sew block together in rows, pressing with opposing seams

Please put your name and town on the back of your block with an address label. The more blocks that you make the more chances you have to win!!!

This block would make an interesting border on a quilt or a quilt itself.
