

2020 Lone Stars Revisited

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Class Description: Admit it, you love the Lone Star, but are afraid to make one because you see all the matched intersections and set in seams. Would you like to learn a painless way to assemble this star and express your own creativity while doing so? Select fun scrap fabrics from your stash or purchase new fabrics for the scrappy star. Jelly rolls also work well for this class. A short trunk show will complete this class.

Class supply list: Sewing machine in good working order. Scissors, rotary cutter, 6" x 24" ruler, and mat. Must have 45 degree angle marked on the ruler. Thread, neutral, notebook and pencil. Several qt. sized plastic bags. Silk pins, with or without heads, seam gauge, like the one used in sewing clothing. Fabrics: pick one focus fabric and choose fabrics that compliment it. Don't get too matchy matchy, Be sure to add a zinger and the odd ball fabric. Make this fun. Black and white always work. You will need about 25 fabrics $\frac{1}{4}$ yd. each. You will need about $1 \frac{1}{2}$ yd of a fun, BG fabric. Step out of your comfort zone and try a print.
