

"Dizzy Daisy" Friendship Block

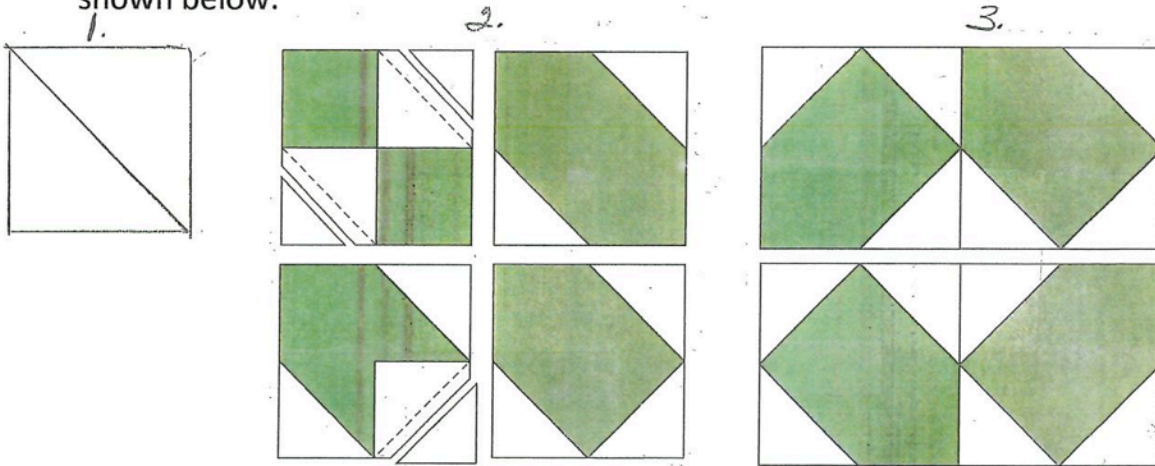
Friendship blocks

Dizzy Daisy Block 9" finished size (9 ½ "unfinished)

For each block you will need: 4- 5" squares of same fabric (bright colors)

12-2 ½ "squares of white

1. On the reverse side of the 2 ½" squares, draw or crease a line from corner to corner on the diagonal for a sewing line as shown below.
2. Place a marked 2 ½" square on each of 3 corners of the 5" square to "snowball" them. Stitch on the line as shown below. Trim these 3 corners leaving a ¼" seam allowance. Press corners out. Repeat on each 5" square.
3. Sew 4-5" squares together with ¼" seam allowance in a four-patch as shown below.



For each block that you make, your name is put into the drawing. Make as many blocks as you want. The more blocks you make, the more chances to win! Write your name, hometown and year on each block. The winners will also receive a copy of the pattern to make this quilt.
