

Mini Blended Fabric Art Collage

Skill level: Beginner

You will create a 6 x 8" collage made of tiny pieces of fabric combined to make a small landscape scene. Your landscape will be suitable for framing or finishing as a mini quilt wall hanging. I will discuss light source, and how to add dimension to your scene using paint. You will be instructed on the use of Misty Fuse. I will show several ways to finish your collage. We will not be doing any sewing in this class.

Supplies included: all fabrics needed to make your collage, fusible product, and use of paint and brush for the landscape scene. Borders, binding and back are not included. You do not need this for the class. Wait until your scene is complete to decide how you want to finish it.

Supplies you will need to bring:

Long pointed tweezers (long ones work best, but if you only have short ones, they will work)

1 piece of corrugated cardboard 10" x 10"

Rotary cutter – 28mm or 45mm

6 – 12" ruler

Small cutting mat (can be shared)

Small and large fabric scissors



Additional \$15 supply fee which includes all fabrics, fusible product, glue, paint & brush.
