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### T-shirt Quilt using BQ6 pattern

- a. Description:
  - i. Have you always wanted to use those T-shirts to make a unique quilt? This is a great class to learn how to incorporate T-shirts into a basic pattern that will create an heirloom. You will be able to prepare the T-shirt with the appropriate backing and “fit” it into the block. This quilt would finish 36” x 54”.
- b. Skill Level:
  - i. Confident beginner
- c. Supply list:
  - i. Sewing machine in good working order
  - ii. Basic sewing supplies
  - iii. Rotary cutting supplies
  - iv. Pattern (BQ6) (Available in class)
  - v. Fabric as suggested on the pattern (except the larger print as we will be using T-shirts for this part).
  - vi. Basic thread for piecing
  - vii. 6 t-shirts
- d. Pattern is \$10 and is available to purchase from Backdoor Quilts. T-shirts would need to be able to get a 12.5” square from them – nothing bigger than that for the class
- e. Students may contact me to do a little preclass work – just cutting the extra pieces for the quilt top (I don’t want them to precut the T-shirts). We can also have discussion about different patterns and why/why not they would work for t-shirt quilts. I will have a few more samples of different quilts using T-shirts.

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
