



Quilt Wyoming 2022 Challenge Guidelines

A big part of quilting is making friends. Think back on all the friendships you have made attending Quilt Wyoming Conventions in the past or friends that you have made quilting in general either taking classes or teaching classes or sharing ideas and projects. For the last 25 years, Quilt Wyoming has introduced a different Friendship Block each year, all of which can be found on the Wyoming State Quilt Guild website. www.wsqg.org under the Quilt Wyoming tab on the menu.

Keeping the “Spirit of Friendship” in mind for this Challenge, you will be asked to use one or more of the Friendship Blocks from the past 25 years in your quilt. You can use “one” favorite friendship block or select several to use to create your Challenge Quilt. Your Challenge Quilt must also incorporate at least one friendship block made by one of your quilting friends.

1. Quilt must have a perimeter of 100”. (It can be a square 25” x 25” – or rectangular 15” x 35” or 20” X 30” for example).
2. Each block in your quilt must include a silver fabric of your choosing in recognition of our 25th Anniversary.
3. Quilts must have 3 layers and a finished edge. No unfinished quilts.
4. Attach a label to the back of the quilt. Include the name of the quilt and the names of contributing quilters.
5. Also, please include a separate typed write up giving a brief story about the name of the quilt and the Friendship Blocks you choose to use. Include any other items of interest you would like to share about your quilt. Do not include any names of quilters involved in making the quilt, as these will be hung up next to the quilts while on display.
6. Quilts need to be turned in for display at the QW2022 registration desk.
7. Cash prizes will be awarded for the top three quilts based on People’s Choice.
