



## Zippers

74" X 82"

This is a fun quilt for beginners on up to experts. Large pieces and no triangles make this a fast quilt to put together. Choose the border fabric first and pull colors from that for the zippers!

### Fabrics:

Choose your border fabric first. I would choose a medium to large print with several different colors in it. A black background for this fabric would be a plus because we are using black in the quilt.

From this border fabric choose 3 color families (like purple, orange and blue, whatever colors are in your fabric). You will need 2 fabrics from each color family. I would pick ones that are more tone on tone or not too much print to them. You will want a medium light and medium dark for each color. Plus you will need a background fabric.

Background fabric – 1  $\frac{3}{8}$  yards – I used a light grey  
Black fabric  $\frac{3}{8}$  yard  
Border fabric – 1  $\frac{3}{8}$  yards  
For the remaining 6 medium fabrics you will need  $\frac{3}{8}$  yard if each.

### Cutting before class:

From each of your 6 medium fabrics cut 2 – 8  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips  
From the black fabric cut 6 – 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips and 8 – 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips  
From background fabric cut 4 – 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips and 14 – 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips  
From border fabric cut 8 – 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips
