## ANNIVERSARY JEWELS - QW22 FRIENDSHIP BLOCK

6-inch square Finished. Make as many blocks as you like.
To achieve a three-dimensional illusion of jewel facets please use only SOLID color $100 \%$ cotton for each block:

Black for your background plus 3 values of any jewel color (light, medium, dark) per block. You will cut 2 triangles from the Medium fabric, and 1 triangle each from the Light and Dark fabrics.

Examples: Ruby, Emerald, Sapphire, Garnet, Topaz, Diamond, etc.

Please use a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance.
Using your favorite method, cut and sew four half-square triangle (HST) units measuring exactly $3.5^{\prime \prime}$ square unfinished, pressing as noted below.

Lay out 4 units as illustrated. Sew units together to make a $61 / 2$ inch square unfinished block, nesting center seams.
