



Evening Kites Supply List revised 2023

Kite blocks are the focus of this quilt, that looks like it is set against a darkened sky. A perfect design for someone who likes a little challenge. This is a template quilt with the Evening Kites Templates within the pattern. 4 different quilt blocks make up this quilt: 3 different kite blocks and the Hidden Star Block is made up of Square in a Square blocks.

The setting is "on point" so a lot of new techniques to be tried.

Finished Size: 80"x 97" (32 – 12 ½" blocks)

Level: Intermediate

Class: 1 day class

Pattern: "Evening Kites" by Bound to be Quilting , \$11.00

Fabric Requirements:

- 4- 5/8 yards Dark Blue (includes binding)
- 1 yard Dark Blue Floral w/Birds
- ¾ yard Dark Blue Floral
- ¾ yard Medium Blue
- 2 ¼ yards White Floral
- 1 ½ yards Orange
- 1 5/8 yards Yellow
- 7 1/3 yards Backing

Basic Sewing Supplies :

- Sewing Machine in good working order, ¼" foot or setting on machine) a new needle. Don't forget your Cords, machine and extension cord.
- Extra Light (if you need it)
- Piecing Thread (I use Aurifil, a shade of gray, Bottom line by Superior for bobbin)
- Small traveling iron and an ironing surface (wool mat, ironing table etc.)
- Pins & Seam Ripper
- Rotary cutter and small mat 12" x 18"
- Marking pen or pencil (I use Frixion pens .05 or .07)
- Bring the templates that you made from the pattern (in Pre-cutting before class)

Pre-cutting Assignment before class.

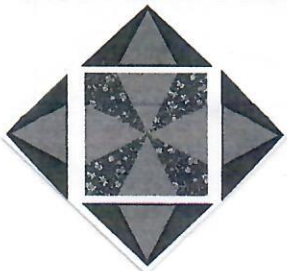
Use the template pattern provided in the pattern to make the 3 templates out of plastic or cardboard for the kite blocks. Be precise with the templates (this is what makes this pattern intermediate!) Make up at least 2 blocks of each Kite A, Kite B, and Kite C. And 2 blocks of the Hidden Star Block. Label the parts and put in baggies until class.

Kite A : cut for 1 block (12 ½"x 12 ½") make 2 for class (make 6 blocks total for pattern)

Dark blue fabric = (4) template B + (4) template B reversed (look on pattern)

Orange = (8) template A

Blue floral/birds = (4) template C



More precutting assignments on page 2

Pre-cutting Assignment before class. Continued from page 1

Cut and package 2 blocks of Kite A, Kite B, Kite C, and Hidden Star Block. Bring to class.

Kite B : cut for 1 block (12 ½"x12 ½") make 2 and bring to class (Make 6 blocks total for pattern)

Dark blue fabric : (4) Template B + (4)

White floral : (8) Template A

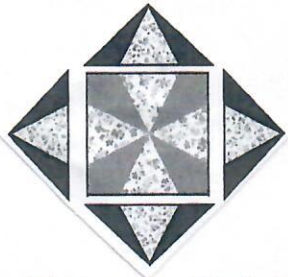
Dark blue/bird : (4) Template C

Kite C: cutting for 1 block (12 ½" x 12 ½") make 2 and bring to class (Make 10 blocks total for pattern)

Dark blue fabric: (4) template B + (4) Template B reversed (look at pattern)

White floral : (8) Template A

Orange : (4) Template C



Hidden Star Block: This block requires (4) square-in- a- square units for each block. I will give you 2 different cutting methods for the square-in- a- square unit. You may choose which one to use or 1 of each, to bring to class. PLEASE don't cut both for the whole quilt because you will have twice what is needed. Each method produces a 4 ½" unit. (make 10 blocks total for quilt)

Square-in-a-Square #1 (from the pattern)

Dark blue fabric : (4) 2 7/8" squares cut corner to corner (8 triangles)

Yellow : (4) 2 7/8" squares cut corner to corner (8 triangles)

Dark blue floral: (4) 3 3/8" squares

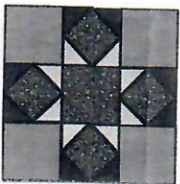
OR

Square-in -a-square #2 (quick method from Gerri Robinson using fold & flip method)

Dark blue fabric: (8) 2 ½" squares

Yellow: (8) 2 ½" squares

Dark blue floral: (4) 4 ½" x 4 ½" squares



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Med. Blue (4) 4 ½" squares

Dark blue floral (1) 4 ½" square (middle square)
