

Quilt Wyoming 2023 Quilting Stars Friendship Block  
Star in a Star



**Inner Star: White on White**

**CUT for Inner Star:**

- 1 - Red or Blue 4½" x 4½" (A)\*
- 4 - White 2½" x 2½" (B)\*
- 4 - Red or Blue 2" x 2" (C)
- 1 - White 3½" (D)

**Outer Star: Blue or Red**

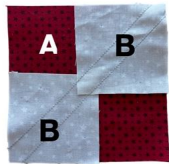
**CUT for Outer Star:**

- 1 - White 7½" x 7½" (A)\*
- 4 - Red or Blue 4" x 4" (B)\*
- 4 - White 3½" x 3½" (C)

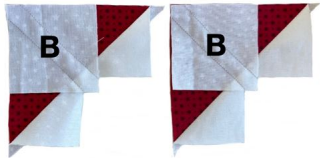
\* If you like to have a little extra to trim cut A & B 1/8" larger

Using the 4 in 1 Flying Geese method make 4 small & 4 large

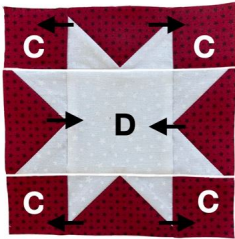
Step 1: Using A and 2 Bs layer as indicated right sides together and sew scant 1/4" from both sides of center line of B. Cut on diagonal then press towards points.



Step 2: Use the remaining 2 Bs, layer as indicated, sew scant 1/4" from both sides of center line of B. Cut on diagonal then press towards points. Trim small geese to 2" x 3½" and large to 3½" x 6½".



Step 3: Sew inner star together, press seams toward Cs & D, trim to 6½" x 6½".



Step 4: Sew outer star together, press seams toward flying geese, trim to 12½" x 12½".



Variations would be to use red, white & blue fabric instead of red or blue. Or reverse the colors so the center star is red or blue and the outer white on white. Or use white with a small red or blue print.
