

Hearts and Flowers

Supplies Needed:

- Free pattern - please download this yourself. Please do not copy or distribute (due to website limitations) for anyone else.

- Sewing Machine and Basic quilting supplies
- Thread to coordinate with fabric (you will be satin stitching several different colors)
- Rotary cutter, mat & long ruler
- Pencil
- Optional but highly recommended- stitch & tear light or heavy or heavy duty (regular tissue paper). Instructor will have some day of class to buy at cost to stabilize fabric when satin stitching)

Fabric Needed:

- 2-1/2 yards total of assorted prints for blocks and appliques**
- 1-1/3 yards for border
- 1/2 yard for binding
- 2-7/8 yards of backing fabric
- 51x54" of quilt batting
- 2 yards of lightweight fusible web (EX: Heat & Bond *light*, wonder under)

I highly recommend cutting the squares before attending class.** This is a good time to appliqué and get part of the wall hanging stitched together. See pattern for an efficient way to cut squares— do so in order.

By cutting the fabric ahead of time, it will also give you a good idea of how you want to use and how much of each you need. The wall hanging in the photo uses the colors (yellow, purple, pink, blue, orange-yellow, green, red) but there are many other colors within the color family to add texture and depth.

**The pattern will tell you exact measurements for each block – however to account for shrinkage that happens when machine appliquing, I recommend you make the block just a bit larger. For example—pattern calls for 15 - 5 x 4 3/4" squares for star applique blocks. Cut 15 blocks that are 5 1/4" x 5". Once stars are machine appliqued and pressed, then you will cut the block to the actual size. This is OPTIONAL— but it does make the quilt flatter and more accurate.
