

## Tilted Log Cabin

Block will finish approximately 9". After altering I trim to 8 1/4"

This is a scrappy quilt – best choices are really light and really dark fabrics, but I am excited to see what you decide to choose.

You will be happy if you choose an accent square for the center of the block. My suggestion is a 1 1/2" square as we will be working with 1 1/2" strips. We will be using 8 lights and 8 darks as well as the accent square.

PLEASE DO NOT START SEWING BLOCKS TOGETHER. Feel free to have strips cut and ready for sewing.

### 16 Blocks

Fabrics	strips	Est. amounts of fabrics
Lights	16	24" WOF total
Darks	19 1/2	29 1/4" WOF total

### 48 Blocks

Fabrics	strips	Est. amounts of fabrics
Lights	48	72" WOF total
Darks	58	87" WOF total

## Class Supplies

Working machine with cords and foot control

At least 9" square up ruler, rulers for cutting strips

Paper, pencil to take notes

Pin, clips to keep blocks organized

Rotary cutter, scissors

Cutting mat

Threads

Extension cords, lights

Iron and iron pad

Any tools you feel you will need while sewing.

I will have a heavy plastic for you to have for the pattern process. A pen or sharpie to write on it might be a good idea.
