


service!



The local quilt guilds and other quilt groups are accomplishing great things this winter.

Each participant will make a 12" to 16" center that will be passed to four other people to add a border. The quilt will then be returned to the owner to finish as they want. Members have been making small quilts to donate to various causes in the county. Future projects will be decided at the January meeting. The guild meets on the last Monday of each month at the Cody Senior Center, at 5:30 in the winter and 6:30 in the summer.

The first semester of Quilts of Valor enrichment at Cody Middle School has had eight eager students participating in the endeavor. Their fifteen weeks of an hour every Friday have resulted in two completed quilts so far and a third one that will be completed by the end of the semester. We have been blessed to have one staff teacher and six volunteers from the community who give of their time to teach these students about the ins and outs of quilt making. Many quilters in our community and our local quilt shop have donated material and rulers to help our growing numbers. Recently, an angel donated eight Featherweight machines for our enrichment and the kids love them!

We have also been able to extend our Friday classes for two hours with the permission of the school district if the students want to stay. Currently, there are eight individual projects being made! The joy is seeing the kids grow and become more confident in their skills and seeing them bond with each other. They jump in and help each other when needed. We welcome visitors to come see what we are doing!



MYSTERY QUILT - FINAL CLUE #4

Big as a Mountain

You should have all of the blocks sewn and ready to put together.

Follow the quilt clues to create an easy and fun quilt top that measures 60" x 70".

Plan to share a picture of your finished quilt top on Facebook and in Patchwords.

Hopefully we will have several finished quilts on display at Quilt Wyoming 2024.

WE HOPE YOU ARE HAVING FUN SOLVING THIS MYSTERY!

The instructions and diagrams for piecing each block are on the website, www.wsqg.org. There is a tab along the top of the website.



Row 1 -- Place one of Block #A in upper left corner, next Block #B, Block #C. Block #B and Block #A. Sew blocks together. Make two sets. (ABCBA)

Row 2 -- Place one of Block #B in upper left corner, next three Blocks #C, and end with Block #B. Sew blocks together. Make two sets. (BCCCB)

Row 3 -- Sew five #C blocks together. Make two sets. (CCCCC)

Sew the rows together: 1-2-3-3-2-1.

Borders:

Measure through the center of the quilt top, both length and width.

From the 4-1/2" strips of fabric #2, cut two to length measurement and two to width measurement.

Sew longer strips onto sides. Press to border.

Sew 4-12" square of fabric #1 on each end of remaining strips. Press to fabric #2. Sew one strip on to the top and one on to the bottom.

Quilt and Bind:

Quilt as desired and bind with the remaining 2-1/2" wide strips of fabric #3
