
Supply List for

Stacked Ovals by Ilene Bartos





- Extension Cords and Irons if not provided
- Sewing Machine that can zigzag, with normal attachments; but include the following:
 - Open Toe Foot
 - Darning or Free-Motion Quilting Foot IF you get to the quilting stage
 - We will be using a blanket stitch so it would be helpful if you know where to find it on your machine. If you do not have a blanket stitch, you can use a zigzag instead.

Threads:

- Solid thread to match your solid fabrics (color version)
- Black <u>and</u> White thread (dark/light version)
- Rotary cutter, mat, ruler
- Scissors both paper and fabric
- Marking chalk and pencils
- Glue Stick and/or Basting glue
- Freezer Paper
- Stabilizer such as Pattern Ease approximately 1 yard

- Scraps of any kind of Batting
- You can buy Kits which include the pattern as follows:
 - o Dark/Light Version for \$57.00
 - o Color Version for \$47.00
- o Or bring your own fabrics as follows, and buy just the pattern for \$15.00

Dark/Light Version:

- ¼ yard each of 5 different Dark Fabrics (black with white designs) and 5 different light fabrics (white with black designs)
- o 1 yard black and ½ yard white for background and binding

Color Version:

- ¼ yard each of 9 different colored fabrics
- 1 yard black and ½ yard dark gray fabric for background and binding
- 1-2 yards of fusible web (such as Soft Fuse)
