Bowtie Disco is a fun modern take on creative placement of HSTs (half square triangles) among a solid or a scrappy background! This uniquely simple quilt brings unlimited options to play with colors and fabrics. I wanted to create a way to offer a mostly background fabric quilt with dots of color that could evoke many different feels.

Here's a few ideas to get you started.

For a three color quilt: Choose a background color that you love with two contrasting colors for the triangles.

For a really scrappy quilt: You'll need a lot of low volume fabrics for the background. Then choose a color or two to make scrappy HSTs.

For a fun partly scrappy quilt: Choose a background color. Then choose a pile of 5" squares or a charm pack to make your HSTs.

Basic Tools:

Working Sewing Machine

Rotary Cutter

Ruler with diagonal line from corner to corner (minimum size 8" x 8")

Cutting Mat (minimum size 10" x 10")

Thread

Pins

Seam Ripper

Ironing Mat (optional)

Travel Iron (optional)
