Quilt Wyoming 2024, Cheyenne, WY

This is a fun pattern designed by Natalie Crabtree of Windham Fabrics to feature the Fantasy fabric collection by Sally Kelly. The pattern was a free computer download and I have obtained permission to provide it to you for this class. The quilt will finish at approximately $81 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 81 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$.

This class is a ONE-day class. To maximize sewing time, you will be required to do some pre-cutting and sorting. To successfully participate you must have a good working knowledge of your sewing machine and general understanding of a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance, rotary cutting, and have experience piecing. ## Supplies and Preparation:

Main Background Fabric - $3^{1 / 2}$ yards, or $41 / 4$ yards if using this fabric for binding* Block Fabrics - 13 coordinating fabrics, pre-cut, labeled and bagged as directed below *Binding Fabric - if not using main background, 3/4 yard

## Label and Clip or Bag:

Fabric A - Background
A-1: 4 generous $43 / 8$ " $\times$ WOF strips; sub cut into 36 generous $43 / 8$ " squares
A-2: Cut 23 " $\times$ WOF strips; sub cut strips into 362 " $\times 3$ " rectangles
A-3: Cut $213 / 4$ " $\times$ WOF strips; sub cut strips into $3613 / 4 " \times 2$ " rectangles
A-4: CUT 17 " $\times$ WOF strip; sub cut strip into 361 " $\times 7$ " rectangles
A-5: Cut $183 / 4$ " $\times$ WOF strip; sub cut strip into 361 " $\times 83 / 4$ " rectangles
A-6: Cut $51 \frac{1}{4 \prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips; sub cut strips into $361 \frac{1}{4}$ " $\times 3$ " rectangles AND $3611 / 4 " \times 13 / 4$ " rectangles
A-7: Cut $1101 / 2$ " $\times$ WOF strip; sub cut strip into 361 " $\times 101 / 2$ " rectangles
A-8: Cut 1 10" $\times$ WOF strip; sub cut strip into 361 " $\times 10$ " rectangles
A-9: Cut $201 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips; sub cut strips into $601 \frac{1}{2 \prime} \times 121 / 2$ " rectangles
A-10: Cut $921 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips for the border
Fabric B-5/8 yard: Cut 63 " $\times$ WOF strips; sub cut into 183 " $\times 11^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles

Fabric C-1⁄2 yard: Cut 6 2" x WOF strips; sub cut into 182 " $\times 121 / 2 "$ rectangles
Fabric D-1/4 yard: Cut 5" $\times$ WOF strips; sub cut into $1813 / 4 " \times 5$ " rectangles
Fabric E-3/4 yard: Cut 15 " $\times$ WOF strip; sub cut into $1813 / 4$ " $\times 5$ " rectangles
Cut 6 3" $\times$ WOF strips; sub cut into $183^{\prime \prime} \times 11$ " rectangles
Fabric F - $1 / 2$ yard: Cut 62 " $\times$ WOF strips; sub cut into 182 " $\times 121 / 2 "$ rectangles

Fabric G-1/2 yard: Cut 5 3" WOF strips, sub cut into $183^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2$ " rectangles
Fabric H-1/2 yard: Cut $53^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips, sub cut into $183^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2$ " rectangles
Fabric I-1/2 yard: Cut $281 / 4$ " $\times$ WOF strips, sub cut into $581 / 4$ " squares, then cut squares twice diagonally to create $\mathbf{2 0}$ quarter square triangles

Fabric J-3/8 yard: Cut $183 / 4$ " $\times$ WOF strip; sub cut into $1813 / 4$ " $\times 83 / 4$ " rectangles
Fabric K-1/4 yard: Cut $181 / 4$ " $\times$ WOF strip; sub cut into $481 / 4$ " squares, then cut squares twice diagonally to create 16 quarter square triangles. From remainder of $81 / 4$ " strip, cut $511 / 2$ " squares

Fabric L-3/8 yard: Cut 3 3" $\times$ WOF strips; sub cut into 183 " $\times 6$ " rectangles
Cut $11 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times$ WOF strip; sub cut into $161 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares
Fabric M-3/8 yard: Cut $183 / 4$ " $\times$ WOF strip; sub cut into $1813 / 4$ " $\times 83 / 4$ " rectangles
Fabric N-3/8 yard: Cut 3 3" $\times$ WOF strips; sub cut into 183 " $\times 6$ " rectangles

## Additional Sewing Supplies:

High quality, thin, neutral colored thread for piecing - I suggest Aurifil 50 wt.
Sewing machine in good working order

Extra needles and bobbins
Seam Ripper
Straight Pins
Purple Thang or other stiletto type tool
Rotary cutter (new blade), ruler and cutting mat
Clover Perfect Press or other rotary pressing tool. (not absolutely necessary, but I find it useful)
$121 / 2$ " square ruler (if you have one)
