

Black, white and a bit of color make a striking quilt. We will have fun piecing this easy to make quilt. Pull out those white on black and black on white fabrics along with a stack of bright  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares and we are ready to play. Mitered corners on the borders and you have a great finish. You can make this any size you like by adjusting the number of blocks made. My quilt is 64" x 76" and uses 99 blocks. No pattern needed. I will provide the instructions at class.

### **Cutting Instructions**

1. From black on white fabric (dark)
  - a. 99 matching sets of 3 –  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares and 1 – 3" square
  - b.  $\frac{1}{2}$  yd border fabric
2. From white on black fabric (light)
  - a. 99 matching sets of 3 –  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares and 1 – 3" square
  - b.  $\frac{1}{2}$  yard border fabric
3. From colorful fabric
  - a. 99 –  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

If you like you can pair up one set of the dark and one set of the light prior to class or wait until class to play. Just remember to keep the sets together.
