

## Colorway

This is a fun quilt to use up those matching layer cakes and jelly rolls that seem to find their way into our stash. You can also make this with scraps from your stash if you want too.

### Materials Needed for Class

You will need the *Colorway by Camille Roskelley of Thimble Blossoms* pattern. Check with your local quilt store, a friend or order online at [www.thimbleblossoms.com](http://www.thimbleblossoms.com) for \$8.95 (you can order a paper pattern or PDF pattern to download).

1 Layer Cake (or 36 – 10" squares)

1 Jelly Roll (or 36 – 2 ½" x 42" strips)

3 ¾ yards background fabric

¾ yard binding fabric (will not need for class)

4 ¾ yard backing fabric (will not need for class)

### Prep Prior to Class:

1. From background fabric, cut the following:
  - a. 15 strips 4" x WOF. Subcut into 4" x 4" squares – 144 total
  - b. 8 strips 2" x WOF. Subcut into 2" x 2" squares – 144 total
  - c. 4 strips 2 ½" x WOF. Subcut into 2 1/2" x 2" rectangles – 72 total
  - d. 6 strips 2 ½" x WOF. Subcut into 2 ½" x 5 ½" rectangles – 36 total
  - e. 8 strips 2 ½" x WOF for borders. Set aside.
2. From 36 Layer Cake squares or 10" squares, cut the following:
  - a. Cut 4 – 4 ½" squares from each.
3. From 36 Jelly Roll strips, cut the following from each strip:
  - a. Cut 4 – 2 ½" x 5 ¾" rectangles
  - b. Cut 4 – 2 ½" x 4" rectangles
