## Materials for CHANDELIER

2 charm packs or 7 fat quarters or scraps

3 yards of contrasting background fabric

5/8 yard of binding fabric

## Cutting for CHANDELIER

For the Blocks

## (from 2 charm packs)

Organize the charm squares into 41 matching pairs. From each pair, reserve 1 square 5" $\times$ 5" and subcut 2 squares $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ from the other. (Set aside the other half of square to use for border).

## Or (from 7 fat quarters)

From each fat quarter:

Cut two strips 5" x $22^{\prime \prime}$ and subcut into six squares 5" x 5". Cut two strips $21 / 2$ " x $22^{\prime \prime}$ and subcut into 12 squares $2 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. Organize the squares by print.

Or (from Scraps)
Gather or cut 41 sets with each set containing 1 square $5^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$ and two squares $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ of the same print.

## Contrasting Background Fabric

*Cut 2 strips $133 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF. Subcut each strip into 2 squares $133 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 133 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ and 1 square 6 7/8" x 6 7/8".
*Subcut each 13 3/8" square into 4 triangles by cutting along both diagonal lines to yield 16 side triangles total.
*Subcut each $67 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ square into 2 triangles by cutting along one diagonal line to yield 4 corner triangles total.
*Cut 17 strips $2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF. Subcut into $2 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 7$ " rectangle, 5 per strip until you have 82.
*Cut 11 strips $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF. Subcut into $2 \frac{112 \prime \prime}{2} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles, 8 per strip, until you have 82.
