

Barb Gorges “Remembering your Quilt Class

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Class supply list (*Include any pre-cutting instructions.*)

Bring a quilt you've made, preferably with a hanging sleeve sewn or pinned on the back side near the top (shouldn't be visible from the front).

As much information about the quilt as you can collect: title, makers (including quilter if someone else), size, techniques used, date started, date finished, future recipient (occasion), pattern, fabric notes, batting type, inspiration.

Scraps of fabric from that quilt, 2 x 2 inches is adequate unless there are large-scale prints.

A scrap of light to medium solid-colored fabric 6 x 6 inches that blends with the back of the quilt, or muslin, to make a label for the quilt.

Needle and thread (thread that contrasts with border or edge of quilt)

Fabric scissors and pins

Pencil and small see-thru rotary cutting ruler, at least 6 x 6 inches.

Smart phone with camera (or use teacher's)
