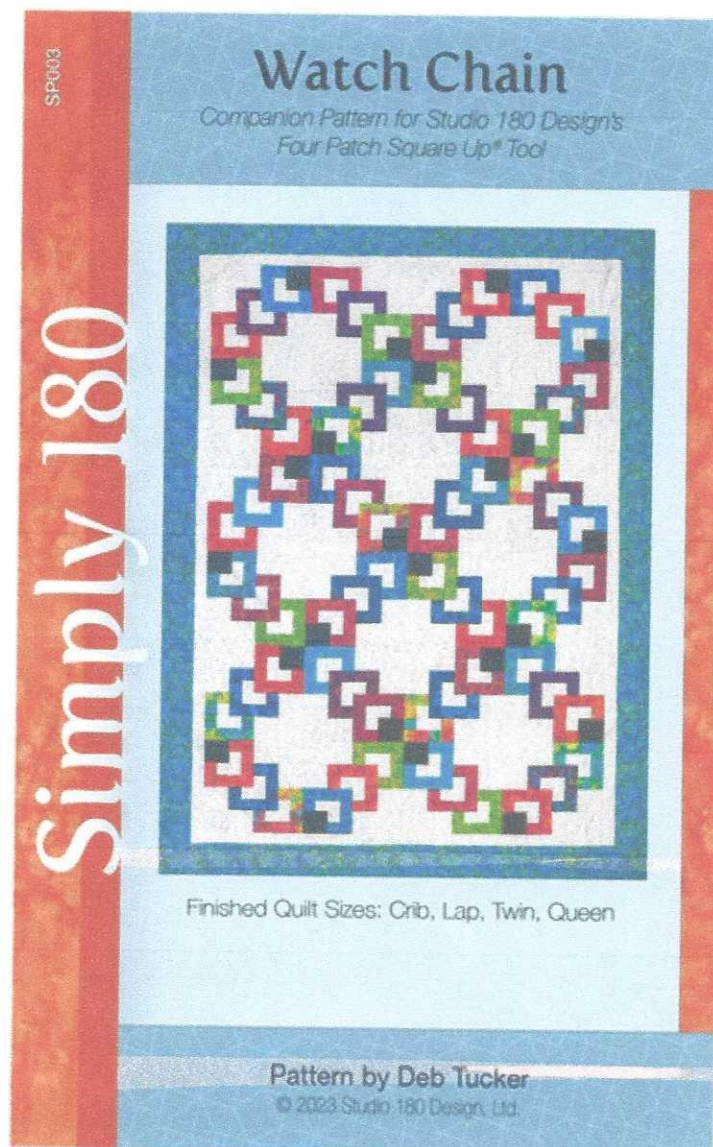


Watch Chain

70" x 70"

What a fun way to use the Four Patch Square Up tool! This quilt uses a modified four patch to make linked chains that remind us of the chain on pocket watches. Easily assembled with squares and rectangles, by the end of this project you will be a pro at making these fun Watch Chain blocks!

Quilt can be made in crib, lap, twin or queen, class will focus on the lap.



Watch Chain

Supply List

Watch Chain Pattern
Four Patch Square Up Tool
InvisiGrip for back of tool (optional but recommended)
Sewing Machine
Cutting mat and rotary cutter with new blade
6 x 24" or similar favorite ruler
General sewing kit – scissors, pins, seam ripper, machine needles, thread, bobbins, etc.

Fabric Requirements

Dark	¼ yd
Background	2-1/4 yd
2-1/2" x 43" Medium Strips*	24 strips
Inner Border	½ yd
Outer Border	2/3 yd
Binding	5/8 yd

* For this pattern, your 2-1/2" strips need to have 43" of usable fabric. Measure your strips before you start to ensure they are long enough. Or find or cut two strips of the same fabric.

Cutting Instructions

Dark	Cut 2 strips 4" x WOF; subcut into 16 Squares 4" x 4"
Background	Cut 4 Strips 4" x WOF; subcut into 32 squares 4" x 4" Cut 2 strips 15-1/2" x WOF; subcut into 24 rectangles 2-1/2" x 15-1/2" Cut 4 strips 7-1/2" X WOF; subcut into 32 rectangles 4" x 7-1/2"
Medium Strips	from each of 24 strips cut 1 rectangle 2-1/2" x 15-1/2" <i>Save remainder of each strip. If the remainder of the strip is less than 27-1/2", have or cut another strip 2-1/2" of the same fabric for step 6</i>

The remaining borders may be cut later.
