# 2024 Mystery Quilt 

## For a 48" by 60 " quilt

*One Jelly Roll (40 Strips by Width of Fabric). If you have 2 extra strips that match your Jelly Roll, it will make the piecing easier (total of 42).
$2 / 3$ yard fabric that contrasts ALL of the fabrics in the Jelly Roll. Or, 8-2 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips

For example, if your jelly roll is all blacks and whites, you'll want something really bright, red, lime green, bright pink, etc. If it is all shades of a similar color, look for something that will really show up. If your Jelly Roll is a lot of busy prints, look for a semi-solid that will show up against all of them. When selecting your contrast fabric, you're looking for that striking pop of color/contrast. If you wish to use the contast fabric for borders as well, 2 yards will give you a 4 " border and all of the smaller pieces.

Neutral thread

## Basic Sewing Supplies

Sewing Machine in good working order, that gets a good $1 / 4$ seam allowance
Fresh Needle
Chalk Marker
Pencil - that will show up on your contrast fabric
Sewing/Binding clips
Pins
Rotary cutter and Mat
Rulers: Minimum dimensions $61 / 2$ " square (can be larger, but must be at least 6 $1 / 2 "$ square)
Sharp Scissors
Paper and Pen/Pencil for taking notes.
If you wish to make a larger quilt, a second Jelly Roll and double the contrast fabric will make a quilt 96 " x 120".
