

## Big Top Quilt Supply List

1. Big Top Quilt Pattern: available for purchase on <https://www.brigitgail.com/>.
2. Students will receive a discount code for pattern purchase.
3. Refer to the first two pages of the pattern for fabric quantities for the finished quilt top. In class, we will discuss how to use colors in the pattern so you may want to have some extra fabrics on hand so you have some options to choose from.
4. In class, we will make one wedge, so you will need a smaller amount of fabric in class than you will need for the finished quilt.
  - ● 7-10 fat quarters or ¼ yard pieces in different colors/prints
  - ● (2) ½ yard pieces in different colors/prints
  - ● (1) 1 yard piecePlease refer to the pattern for some tips/suggestions related to choosing your colors.

### Tools

- Sewing machine
- 50 weight thread
- Rotary cutter (40 mm and 28 mm would be ideal)
- Cutting mat
- Quilting ruler (at least 12" long)
- Small, square quilting ruler (between 3 and 6 inches)
- Add-a-quarter ruler is helpful but not necessary
- Scissors for cutting paper
- Pins
- Pressing mat
- Small (travel) iron

I recommend making your templates before class. If you plan to make the templates in class, you will need:

- Template plastic or cardboard
- Glue stick or double sided tape
- Printouts of the templates

For the paper piecing, you will need **at least one** printout of pages 13 and 14. (You might want to bring several copies in case you want more practice.)
