

Pixel Postage Supply List

1. Pixel Postage Pattern: available for purchase on <https://www.brigitgail.com/>. Students will receive a discount code for pattern purchase.
2. Refer to the pattern for a complete supply list and details about colors and quantities for the finished quilt top.

Fabric quantities needed for class

1. Five or more 1 1/2" width-of-fabric strips of solid background color. Brigit recommends a neutral (shades of white, grays, navy, black, etc.) NOTE: You will need 2 yards of your background color to complete your quilt top but you do not need to have all your yardage in class.

2. Small amounts of a variety of colors cut into 1 1/2" strips between 6 and 10 inches in length.

Most designs will work well with a variety of shades of a few colors—for example, a range of pinks and reds, a range of blues, and maybe a few other colors.

We will discuss how to use color and value to create a pixel picture, so you may want to bring a variety of solid scraps / fat quarters and cut them into strips when you have settled on a design.

Supplies:

- Small, square quilting ruler. 5 1/2" is ideal but 4 1/2" and 6 1/2" will also work.
- Rotary cutter
- Cutting mat
- Small (travel) iron
- Pressing mat
- Sewing machine
- Pins
- 50wt thread

Skills learned

- Precision piecing with scant 1/4" seam
- Color value
