

Flipping Out Case

This is a great case to store and transport your pens, pencils and other sewing tools as you travel. We'll be using a foam stabilizer to create a nice firm case with a zipper. Grab that awesome print that you love and let's make this case. Finished size will be 14.5" H, 5.5" D and 5.5" W.

Any of these supplies can be purchased at Backdoor Quilt Shoppe. With advance notice, I can also bring items with me to the class.

Supply list:

- Basic sewing supplies
- Sewing machine in good working order with a $\frac{1}{4}$ " foot and a walking foot
- Basic rotary cutting supplies
- Pattern purchase is required (they can order them through my shop – Backdoor Quilt Shoppe)
- Thread to match fabrics for topstitching
- Supplies and Yardage requirements as indicated on the pattern.
 1. Main fabric for case – $\frac{1}{2}$ yard
 2. Lining fabric (contrast) – $\frac{1}{2}$ yard
 3. Foam (recommend a fusible product) 15" x 24"
 4. Fusible Interfacing (SF101 or fusible woven) – $\frac{1}{2}$ yard
 5. Mesh fabric (lightweight) – 9" x 24"
 6. Handbag zippers
 - a. One 40" double slide zipper will make two sizes of cases.
 7. 20MM fold over elastic – $\frac{3}{4}$ yard
