

Mountain Lodge Quilt

54" x 72"

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Skill Level: Confident beginner

Class Description: This Mountain Lodge Quilt Class is a "Fun with Triangles Class". Learn how to make and square up Four-at-a time Flying Geese when they aren't "true flying geese (width = 2x height)". The mountains are constructed of squares and half square triangles. We will learn to sew curved seams to make the moon. There will be tips for pressing each of the different sections. We will be able to perfect all of the steps in this quilt while completing the top row. This is a cute quilt that comes together fast.

Supply List:

Sewing Machine in good working order

Basic Sewing Kit

¼" pressor foot

Neutral colored thread

Rotary cutter with sharp blade

Cutting Mat

5" to 8" square up ruler

Wing Clipper (Tucker Trimmers) or other Flying Geese Ruler (optional)

Small personal Iron and ironing surface (optional)

"Mountain Lodge" quilt pattern by Charisma Horton

Fabric Requirements:

Background – 3 yds.

4 Greens – Fat quarters

6 Browns – Fat quarters

Moon (or sun?) – FQ or ¼ yd.

Binding – 2/3 yd.

Backing (44" wide) – 3½ yds.

(In my blue and gold batiks version I used 6 blues and 4 gold/tans instead of the 4 greens and 6 browns called for in the pattern).
