This fun class starts out with glorious fabrics. Pick some fabrics, whether they be beautiful florals, rugged and earthy western themed, Kaffe fabrics of novelty. The sky is the limit! You will learn to cut your fabrics using a 12 inch clam shell ruler which is available from www.latifahsaafirstudios.com. Please don't get a smaller size for this class. After cutting the clammies you will learn to sew them together and you will be amazed at how accurately they assemble. You will also be given ideas for expanding on the basic clamshell. This is a very versatile technique with many creative possibilities.

20-30 fabrics that are at least 14 inches square; fat quarters work well

12" clamshell ruler from latifahsaafirstudio.com

Mat, rotary cutter with medium blade, long narrow pins Sewing machine in good working order Neutral thread and a couple of full bobbins BSK (basic sewing kit) pins, seam ripper, scissors, etc. Notebook and pencil Plastic gallon bag to hold your cut clammies
