A Fabric Lover's Mystery

Materials

42" wide fabric (40" of usable width after washing and removing selvages).

	Lap	Full	King
5" squares in assorted darks and mediums	169 (15 fat qtrs.)	328 (28 fat qtrs.)	547 (46 fat qtrs.)
Background fabric*	2 1/2 yards	4 3/4 yards	7 3/4 yards
Binding	3/4 yard	1 yard	1 1/8 yards
Backing	3 3/4 yards	5 1/3 yards	9 5/8 yards
Batting	64" x 64"	80" x 96"	112" x 112"

^{*}You will want your background fabric to be in high contrast with you darks and mediums



. This mystery quilt is by Pat Speth of Nickle Quilts and the name is from one of the characters in a series of 29 "The Cat Who" books by Lilian Jackson Braun.

You can get 169 5" squares from a layer cake + 1 extra 10" coordinating square. Or just randomly cut 169 5" squares for a very scrappy look.

I would suggest that the lap size quilt is the one to work on for this mystery quilt class so a large part of it can be completed.

Confident beginner and up. SOME PRE-CUTTING IS REQUIRED.

Regular sewing supplies, machine (in good working order with all cords and pedals), 12½" x 12½" ruler, 6½ x 6½" ruler, 6 x 12" ruler, a marking pens/pencils, a *rotary cutting mat is very helpful*.

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
