## Supply list:

10-15 fat quarters (or equivalent) from stash, some of which should read solid.

Also, fabric scissors, rotary cutting tools, offset tweezers (optional), straight pins, pin-able ironing personal ironing board (pins will stand straight up during use - June Tailor Cushioned Quilter's Square 'n Blocker from JoAnns is best, but a wool mat covered with muslin or layers of foam core covered with muslin also work great - 12"x18" suggested minimum size).

Full-size iron (if allowed), "stick"craft irons (if allowed). Spray sizing or starch, optional.

No machines are necessary, as our focus will be on preparation for appliqué, and we can adequately discuss our stitching options.
