We had a great event planned for 2020 which was cancelled due to Covid and we were fortunate to combine forces with the Northwest Region in 2021 to jointly host the event. But that's not the same as actually having you here in our region where we can show off Western

Wyoming Community College and everything else that this region has to offer.

The QW2025 Committee is working hard to put on a great event and we are currently vetting regional instructors and making final choices regarding classes.

Unfortunately, due to deteriorating conditions of the dorms with ongoing repair and remodeling during the summer months, we will not have access to dorm rooms. We know that this may be an economic challenge for many quilters and we are doing everything possible to keep other costs

down. We have entered into contracts with three nearby local hotels to secure hotel rooms at reduced rates. That information will be in the brochure.

In addition to Quilt Wyoming, this area of the Southwest Region has a lot to offer you and anyone else who may be traveling with

you.

President's Corner



Hello 2025!

I'm excited to see in this new year that WSQG continues to make advances in what has been termed the "Digital Age." I proudly share the news that Quilt Wyoming 2025 will be the first to offer an electronic registration and payment option. Please know that paper and snail mail registration will still be

available, and the WSQG Committee, led by Ginny Singer, has taken all the factors into consideration to fairly process all applications.

Speaking of the Digital Age, with all positive things come the negative elements of society. I'm referring to scammers. Unfortunately, our WSQG Board and membership are NOT exempt from that type of low-life activity. And we are seeing a recent spike in their efforts to con us out of money. I'm sharing the following tips, should you receive an email that appears to be from a WSQG Board member. Please note that most often we see the subject line of Wyoming State Quilt Guild on these scams, and they always involve money transactions/requests of some sort.

- 1. Look at the email following the from name (you may need to click on the little arrow to the right of the "from name" to see the actual email address) and verify that it is the valid email for the sender named. Example: From: Di Wilsey Geer <*caestudillo@emya.mx*>
- a. Member email addresses may be verified on our website under Members Only/Membership. Board members with emails are also listed on the inside cover of *Patchwords*.
- b. If you take that action, you'll see the one shown above is NOT my email address-CLUE #1
- 2. If the email message reads something like the following, this is CLUE #2 that you are dealing with fraud:

"How are you doing? Are you available for assistance? I am out of the state now, and I have absolute confidence in you to handle this. The Wyoming State Quilt Guild needs to purchase gift cards to make donations to Veterans in hospice and palliative care units to buy coronavirus disease (COVID-19) prevention items. I'm responsible for the reimbursement. Would you like further information? I wish you happy holidays and health and happiness for 2025!!!"

- 3. Be proactive when the email address and message are suspicious. Take action as follows:
- a. Do NOT try to open any attachments or click on any links.
- b. Block the sender (in Gmail, use the *more* feature (three vertical dots top right) and drop down to block the sender. This blocks the email address, not the named sender.
- c. Do not click on links or attachments. Delete the email.
- 4. There is no need to report such emails to board members and please do not forward them on. Typically, the sender named has not been hacked, the scammers are simply using our name with their email address as in the example above.
- a. We are aware this is happening, and we are making YOU aware of the best actions for YOU to take when a scammer email has been received. We are sorry this is happening. Please be aware and alert when opening and reading emails. Take the quick recommended steps to eliminate. Then get back to quilting!

Do you remember when you first learned to sew and when you finished your first quilt? Think back to that quilt. Who taught you? Where has your journey taken you?

WSQG provides many opportunities for learning and Quilt Camp is one of those activities that is supported by WSQG through funds available to members who are willing to plan and put on a camp.

Quilt Camp has evolved from being a "Kids' Quilt Camp" to a "Quilt Camp" that could include adults learning to quilt. The purpose is to introduce quilting to those who wish to learn, have fun and be creative. Funds must be requested by a WSQG member.

Leadership packet guidelines and the application to request funds can be found at *www.wsqg.org*. Funds will be considered for approval by the Board on a first-come, firstserved basis.







- 2. Laser-cut fabric is about as perfect a cut as you can get; no distortion from rotary cutters.
- 3. You can get a stunning laser cut BLOCK OF THE MONTH. See lower right photo.
- 4. They have a printer that will perfectly print photos on fabric to use in wall hangings or quilts.
