The original quilt uses scraps of plaid fabric, but florals and prints look just as charming. You could even mix it all up and make it a barnyard quilt. How about adding a fence? The process is the same, you are the artist. The eyes are buttons and the tail and mane are embroidery floss so let your imagination soar. Depending on your determination and drive, you could get a couple of animals completed in class and some of your sashing strips (They measure 5" in length). Size of finished quilt is 44" x 52" Look at old coloring books and old patterns to locate other animals if you don't want to do horses. I will be bring animal pictures with me also. Supply list:

- Sewing machine in good working order
- Extra bobbins prefilled
- Freezer paper or Pellon if you prefer for a foundation to sew on instead of freezer paper
- Rotary cutter and mat
- Scissors paper and fabric
- Pencil
- Black thin lined Sharpie
- Basic sewing kit which includes seam ripper, pencil, ect
- You will need approximately $\frac{1}{2}$ Yd of 20 different fabrics to make your animals
- 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ yds for backgrounds and binding.
