Take the mystery out of making a beautiful traditional Temari ball. Participants will learn how to construct the ball using both traditional rice hulls and less traditional modern construction, simple and effective ways to divide the ball, the basic stitch and the Kiku stitch, how to make an obi band and how to weave the threads to make a more complex looking design. This is a hands-on class and no experience is necessary.

Class supply fee: \$45 – fee includes, Threads, materials for making a traditional rice hull or silk center ball and a non-traditional Styrofoam center ball, one pre-wound ball, patterns and a tool kit.
