Supply List:

***Supply List:***

- Pattern
- Sewing machine in good working order (please bring your manual if you are unfamiliar with your machine), cords and pedal
- Neutral 100% thread cotton for piecing. Recommend light grey or tan
- Rotary cutting supplies
- Straight pins (prefer the small glass head pins or flowerhead pins)
- Sewing machine needles (size 11/12 for piecing)
- Basic sewing supplies
- Iron and Ironing Mat
- 1 Jelly Roll OR 8 – 1/6 yards of darks and 8 – 1/6 yards of lights
- 1 1/3 yards cream for borders and flying geese
- 1/3 yards for pumpkin/flower applique
- 1/8 yard green for leaves and stem
- 3 yards rick rack for vine
- 2/3 yard "Steam-A-Seam" fusible webbing
- 1/2 yard binding
- 3 1/3 yards back

Cutting Instructions: Blocks

Jelly roll:

Your 2 1/2" strips are already cut. You need 16 dark and 16 lighter strips.

Yardage:

Cut from each 1/6 yard, 2 – 2 1/2" strips you need to have 16 dark strips and 16 light strips.

From your dark strips cut the following:

One each:     $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 10\frac{1}{2}''$   
                   $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 8\frac{1}{2}''$   
                   $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$   
                   $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 4\frac{1}{2}''$   
                   $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 2\frac{1}{2}''$

Set aside remaining pieces for flying geese

From your light-colored strips cut the following:

One each     $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 8\frac{1}{2}''$   
                   $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$   
                   $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 4\frac{1}{2}''$   
                   $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 2\frac{1}{2}''$
