

Wandering Rose Applique

Would you like to “fine tune” your hand applique techniques? If so, this is the class for you. This block can be made into a pillow or be the “first” block of your sampler quilt.

Topics to be covered are:

- Perfect round circles
- Bias strips
- Smooth out curves
- Smooth applique on an inside V
- A folded bud.

Class fee: \$10 to include mylar plastic, pattern and spray starch.

Supply List:

- 15 ½” square of cotton fabric for background
- Piece of freezer paper 12 inches square
- Fat quarter or scraps of green for 4 bias strips and leaves
- Fat eights or scraps: at least two different flower fabrics or more (we may change our minds)
- Scrap for the center flower circle
- Needles: milliners or straw size 10 or 11
- Paper scissors
- Small sharp fabric scissors
- Applique thread to match fabrics: DMC border machine cotton or YLI Silk
- Black permanent marker
- Pencil
- Thimble
- Small iron and mat
- Small rotary mat and cutter
