

SUMMER WILD FLOWERS WALL HANGING (2-DAY CLASS)

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The participants in the class will use wool applique pieces on cotton fabric. First we will prepare the cotton background and wool for the applique process. Then we will use hand embroidery stitches and beads to embellish the pattern. A variety of sewing and embroidery techniques, using a variety of threads, needles and beads, will be used to produce a fun wall hanging.

Material kit fee per student: \$25 or they can bring their own supplies.

Summer Wild Flowers Pattern fee: \$9

Material kit fee includes: all fabrics (wool and cotton), threads, beads, needles and bonding materials. Partial kits can also be purchased from the instructor.

Basic sewing supplies include:

Applique pins

Small Ruler

Mechanical pencil

Black thread for sewing machine

Small iron and ironing mat

Rotary cutter and cutting mat

6" x 12" ruler

Sewing Machine – with new needles

Sharp small scissors and regular sized scissors

½ Yd of fabric for backing and binding (not necessary to bring to class)

14" x 33" batting (Not necessary to bring to class)

Kit purchased from instructor, or you may provide your own

Assorted black cotton fabrics when sew together in a vertical pattern to produce a 13" x 32" background (6 -1 10 fabrics that will be cut in class)

Black interfacing 12" x 30"

Bonding fabric

Freezer paper

1 fat quarter green wool

6 ½" x 9" gold wool

5" x 5" orange wool

3 ½" x 5 ½" red wool

4 ½" x 8 ½" blue wool

2" x 5" brown wool

3" x 6" white wool

Coordinating threads 5 to 12 weight to match all wool pieces

Variety of beads for the flowers
